

The Messenger of Allah ﷺ said:




## BEST DUA FOR THE DAY OF ARAFAH

**The Prophet ﷺ said:**

The best of dua is the supplication of the Day of ARAFAH.  
And the best of what I and the prophets before me have  
said is:

لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا اللَّهُ وَحْدَهُ لَا شَرِيكَ لَهُ، لَهُ الْمُلْكُ  
وَلَهُ الْحَمْدُ، وَهُوَ عَلَى كُلِّ شَيْءٍ قَدِيرٌ

"None has the right to be worshipped but Allah, the Alone who has no partners, to him belongs Dominion and to Him belong all the Praises, and He has power over all things."

## DHIKR AND TAKBEER

**The Prophet ﷺ said:**

There are no days greater and more beloved to Allah than these ten days of Dhul Hijjah, so increase in them your declaration of the oneness of Allah (Tahleel), your exaltation of Him (Takbeer), and your praise of Him (Tahmeed).

اللَّهُ أَكْبَرُ، اللَّهُ أَكْبَرُ، لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا اللَّهُ،  
وَاللَّهُ أَكْبَرُ، اللَّهُ أَكْبَرُ، وَلِلَّهِ الْحَمْدُ

## REWARD FOR SAYING TAKBEERAT

## Schedule of Takbeerat-e-Tashreeq

اللَّهُ أَكْبَرُ اللَّهُ أَكْبَرُ لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا اللَّهُ  
وَاللَّهُ أَكْبَرُ اللَّهُ أَكْبَرُ وَاللَّهُ الْحَمْدُ

These are the words known as “Takbeerat-e-Tashreeq”, which must be recited once after every obligatory (fard) prayer, starting from Fajr on the 9th of Dhul-Hijjah until Asr on the 13th of Dhul-Hijjah.

## EASY WAY FOR WOMEN TO REMEMBER TAKBEERAAT OF TASHREEQ

From Fajr on the 9th of Dhul-Hijjah to Asr of the 13th of Dhul-Hijjah, reciting the Takbeeraat of Tashreeq is wajib (compulsory) after every salah – men in a raised voice, and women in a low voice.

One effective method to remember this important obligation is to place a simple note labeled "Takbeeraat" on the prayer mat at home.



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**In shaa Allah, through the blessing of this small reminder, women will not forget to recite the Takbeeraat immediately after each salah.**
